Dear Steve,

I never fully realized the significance of Indoor Air Quality until we experienced a major roof leak at our junior-senior high school building during the summer of 1998.

In an effort to recover this flooding catastrophe, I was introduced to the firm of Indoor Air Technologies (IAT). Through their expert consultation, I was made aware of the key role which moisture plays in the growth of mold and mildew. I was also made aware that while mold spores are almost always present in outdoor and indoor air and on all surfaces, there exists a measurable level of acceptability between harmless and harmful.

To be totally on the safe side and to ensure a healthy climate for the longest period possible, the district opted to have IAT apply an Anabec treatment to all areas subjected to water damage. As a result of the roofing incident, we also became aware that the entire district should be scheduled for mold and mildew control as part of a regular maintenance program. The readings before and after the Anabec treatment totally reassured us that this preventive treatment was extremely effective. While we did not experience a dangerous level of mold or mildew in the flooded area, I am sure that if left untreated, we would have experienced a major problem.

The Anabec chemical analysis (ADSA sheet) reassured us that this treatment was safe for use as applied. We intend to continue our aggressive annual plan for such treatments as well as pursuing an ongoing air quality testing program to ensure that our building presents the very safest environment for our students and staff.

In summary we were very pleased with the services of IAT.
